Detailed Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival in Mysore & Local Sightseeing

Morning Travel: From Bengaluru to Mysore

- Start Point: Yeshwanthpur / Rajajinagar area
- Option 1: BMTC Bus to Majestic (Kempegowda Bus Station)

Take BMTC Bus No. 401, 401A, or 401K from Yeshwanthpur Circle → Majestic Bus Station (Approx. ₹20–₹25, 25–30 mins).

- Option 2: Auto / Metro:

Auto to Majestic (~₹100–₹150) or take the Green Line Metro from Yeshwanthpur to Majestic (approx. ₹20).

At Majestic:

- If taking the train, walk to Krantivira Sangolli Rayanna (Bangalore City Station) — 5 mins walk.
- If taking bus, the KSRTC platform for Mysore is right next to the metro exit.

Adventure lovers can trek the Brahmagiri or Tadiandamol peaks, visit elephant camps at Dubare, or enjoy river rafting on the Barapole River.

Culturally rich, Coorg is home to the Kodavas — a proud warrior community known for their distinct traditions, attire, and cuisine. Whether you're sipping hot filter coffee with mountain mist outside your window or walking through spice plantations with your friends, Coorg offers peace, freshness, and a deep connection with nature.



Detailed Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1 : Bengaluru → Coorg (Madikeri) + Arrival Sightseeing

Morning Departure from Bengaluru

- Start Point: Majestic / Satellite Bus Stand (Mysuru Road)
- Transport Option:
 - KSRTC / Private Bus to Madikeri or Kushalnagar (first buses start around 5:30 AM).
 - Duration: ~6–7 hours | Fare: ₹400–₹600 (non-AC/AC seater).
 - Popular routes:
 - Bengaluru → Mysuru (3 hrs) → Kushalnagar → Madikeri (3 hrs)
 - Frequent KSRTC Volvo & Karnataka Sarige buses available.

Arrival at Madikeri Bus Stand (~Noon)

- Take an auto (₹60–₹120) or shared cab to hotel/homestay near town center (Madikeri Fort / Raja's Seat area).
- Freshen up and have lunch.

Afternoon Sightseeing (by Auto / Local Cab Pool):

1. Raja's Seat Viewpoint – Sunset point with valley views, musical fountain (entry ₹20, 6:30 PM show).
2. Madikeri Fort – Historical landmark in town (entry free).
3. Omkareshwara Temple – Sacred 19th-century temple, Indo-Islamic style.
4. Explore Madikeri Market – coffee, spices, homemade chocolates.

Evening:

- Return to hotel by 8 PM.
- Optional: short walk near Raja's Seat park for night city view.

Day 2 – Dubare Elephant Camp + Nisargadhama + Abbey Falls

Morning (7:30 AM):

- Catch local bus or shared jeep to Kushalnagar (30 km / 1 hr).
- From Kushalnagar, take an auto to Dubare Elephant Camp (7 km).
 - Entry ₹30; Elephant bathing & feeding (₹100–₹150 extra).
 - Boat ride across river to reach the camp.
- Early morning visits are best (open 8:30 AM–11:00 AM).

Late Morning:

- Proceed to Nisargadhama Nature Park (3 km from Kushalnagar).
 - Bamboo forest walk, hanging bridge, deer park, and river banks.
 - Entry ₹40.

Lunch:

- Have lunch at Kushalnagar town (recommendations below).

Afternoon:

- Bus / shared jeep back to Madikeri.
- Visit Abbey Falls (8 km from town): local bus to Galibeedu route or shared jeep (₹150 – ₹200 per head).
 - Short trek through spice plantations to reach falls (entry ₹20).

Evening:

- Free time at Raja's Seat for sunset & snacks.
- Explore Madikeri Market or small cafés like Beans & Brews for coffee and dessert.

Day 3 – Talakaveri + Bhagamandala + Return to Bengaluru

Morning (6:30 AM):

- Catch early local bus or hire shared cab (roundtrip ₹250–₹300 per head) to Talakaveri (45 km / 1.5 hrs).
 - Birthplace of River Cauvery, scenic hilltop temple (1,276 m altitude).
 - Optional short trek to Brahmagiri Peak View Point (20–30 mins climb).
- On the way back, stop at Bhagamandala Temple – confluence of three sacred rivers.

Afternoon:

- Return to Madikeri by 1 PM.
- Lunch & checkout.
- Last-minute shopping for Coorg coffee, spices, and handmade chocolates.

Evening Departure:

- KSRTC Bus from Madikeri → Bengaluru (3:30 PM / 5:30 PM / 10:00 PM options).
 - Duration: ~6–7 hours.
 - Arrival at Bengaluru around 10:30 PM / early morning next day.

Kabini:

Welcome to Kabini, Karnataka's pride and one of India's most enchanting wildlife destinations — where nature still breathes wild and free. Once the exclusive hunting grounds of the Maharajas of Mysore, Kabini today stands as a protected sanctuary of untamed beauty, where elephants roam in herds, tigers patrol the riverbanks, and every sunrise feels like a secret shared by the forest.

Located on the banks of the Kabini River, this lush region forms part of the Nagarhole National Park, a UNESCO-recognized biosphere reserve in the Western Ghats. Dense teak forests, mist-covered grasslands, and tranquil backwaters make it a paradise for wildlife lovers, photographers, and anyone seeking peace away from the city's rush.

A boat safari on the Kabini backwaters is one of the most magical experiences — spotting elephants bathing, deer grazing by the shore, and perhaps even the elusive black panther for which Kabini has become world-famous. The jeep safaris inside Nagarhole Tiger Reserve offer thrilling encounters with tigers, leopards, bison, and hundreds of bird species.

But Kabini isn't just about safaris — it's about slowing down. Listening to the forest symphony, watching the sunset turn the river gold, and feeling what true wilderness really means. For students and explorers alike, Kabini is a living classroom — where biology, ecology, and adventure come together in perfect harmony.



Detailed Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1 : Bengaluru → Kabini (Nagarhole) + Arrival at the Riverside

Morning Departure from Bengaluru

- Start Point: Majestic / Satellite Bus Stand
- KSRTC / Private Bus Options:
 - Bengaluru → Mysuru (3 hrs) — KSRTC non-AC every 15–20 mins (₹180–₹250).
 - From Mysuru, change to Mysuru → Kabini (Antharasanthe / Karapura) local bus (2.5–3 hrs, ₹120–₹160).
 - Earliest connecting bus from Mysuru leaves ~8:00 AM; last ~6:30 PM.

Arrival: Kabini / Antharasanthe around 12:30–1:00 PM.

Take an auto or shared jeep (₹150–₹300 depending on resort area) to your accommodation near Kabini Backwaters / Karapura / N. Belathur village.

Afternoon:

- Freshen up and have lunch at local lodge / homestay.
- Short walk by the Kabini River backwaters – perfect for photos, quiet time, and spotting herons, kingfishers, and elephants across the water.

Evening:

- Optional visit to Kabini Dam (15 mins drive from Karapura). Beautiful at sunset with panoramic water views.
- Dinner & early night — tomorrow's safari starts early!

Day 2 – Wildlife Safari + Boat Ride + Tribal Village Visit

Morning (6:00 AM):

- Wake-up call for Jeep Safari inside Nagarhole National Park.
 - Entry via Kabini Gate (Zone A/B).
 - Timings: 6:00–8:30 AM & 3:00–5:30 PM.
 - Tickets can be booked online via <https://karnatakaforest.gov.in> or directly at the forest office (₹500–₹650 per person for students).
 - Spot elephants, gaurs, deer, peacocks, leopards, and with luck, tigers or the famed Black Panther “Saya.”

Late Morning:

- Return to stay by 9:00 AM; breakfast & rest.
- Visit the Kabini Interpretation Centre – educational exhibits on the park’s ecosystem and wildlife conservation.

Afternoon:

- Kabini Boat Safari:
 - Conducted by Jungle Lodges / Forest Dept (₹600–₹900 per head).
 - Timings: 3:30 PM – 5:30 PM.
 - Excellent for bird watching and elephant herds at the river edge.

Evening:

- Back to accommodation; optional bonfire or night talk with naturalist if available.
- Dinner under starlit sky – power backup recommended (some stays switch to solar).

Day 3 – Kabini Backwaters + Mysore Return + Bengaluru

Morning:

- Early morning nature walk near Kabini Backwaters (non-safari zone; permitted trails only).
 - Ideal for photography, bird spotting (eagles, cormorants, drongos).
- Breakfast & checkout.

Return Journey:

- Take local bus / shared jeep to Mysuru (via HD Kote) – ~3 hrs (buses at 9:00 AM, 12:30 PM).
- From Mysuru, KSRTC / Train to Bengaluru (~3 hrs).
 - Train options: Rajya Rani Express (11:30–13:45) or Chamundi Express (18:15–21:05).
- Arrive Bengaluru same evening.

Originally developed by the British as a summer retreat, Ooty still carries that gentle colonial nostalgia — from the Toy Train that chugs through tunnels and tea estates to the charming cottages, botanical gardens, and vintage bakeries that dot the town. Every corner feels cinematic — whether it’s boating on Ooty Lake, strolling through Rose Garden, or sipping hot tea overlooking emerald valleys.

For students and explorers, Ooty is more than a holiday spot — it’s a living classroom on biodiversity, geography, and heritage. Nestled within the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve, it’s home to rare species of flora and fauna, making it a UNESCO-protected ecological zone. Nearby gems like Coonoor, Kotagiri, and Doddabetta Peak add to the experience, offering breathtaking views and short scenic hikes.

The rhythm of life in Ooty is slow, graceful, and deeply connected to nature — it’s a place to breathe deeply, think freely, and rediscover simplicity. Whether you’re watching the mist roll across the tea plantations or enjoying roasted corn by the lake, Ooty has a way of reminding you that the most beautiful journeys are often the quiet ones.



Detailed Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1 : Bengaluru → Ooty (via Mysore / Gudalur) + Arrival Sightseeing

Morning Travel:

- Option 1: KSRTC Bus from Bengaluru → Ooty
 - Board from Majestic (Kempegowda Bus Station).
 - Direct buses: KSRTC Airavat / Karnataka Sarige depart at 6:15 AM, 10:00 AM, and 10:00 PM.
 - Duration: 8–9 hours via Mysore – Bandipur – Gudalur – Ooty.
 - Fare: ₹500–₹700.
- Option 2: Train + Bus Route
 - Take early train (Rajya Rani Express / Tippu Express) from Bengaluru → Mysuru (~3 hrs).
 - From Mysore, board a KSRTC bus to Ooty (~6 hrs, ₹400).

Scenic En Route:

The drive crosses the wildlife-rich Bandipur & Mudumalai Tiger Reserves. Keep an eye out for deer, elephants, and peacocks along the roadside!

Arrival at Ooty Bus Stand (~2:00 PM)

- Auto / shared cab to hotel (₹80–₹150).
- Lunch and freshen up.

Evening Exploration:

1. Ooty Lake & Boathouse – Pedal boats, speed boats (₹180–₹300).
2. Thread Garden (opposite lake; handmade flowers exhibit).
3. Commercial Street / Charring Cross Market – Souvenirs, chocolates, tea, and woollens.

Dinner Suggestion:

- Nahar's Sidewalk Café or Earl's Secret for cozy evenings.
- Return to hotel; overnight stay.

Day 2 – Full Day Ooty Local Sightseeing + Toy Train Ride

Morning:

- Government Botanical Gardens – 22-acre colonial-era garden, 1,000+ plant species (Entry ₹40).
- Government Rose Garden – Over 20,000 rose varieties (Entry ₹40).
- Take auto/shared jeep between both (~₹80).

Afternoon:

- Lunch at Hyderabad Biryani House / Adyar Ananda Bhavan (A2B) – vegetarian options.
- Proceed to Ooty Railway Station for the Nilgiri Mountain Toy Train Ride.
 - Route: Ooty → Coonoor (1 hr 15 mins, ₹30–₹100).
 - Departures: 9:15 AM, 12:15 PM, 2:00 PM (Check availability on IRCTC).

Evening:

- Explore Coonoor Town – Sims Park, Dolphin's Nose View Point.
- Return to Ooty by bus or toy train (~1 hr).

Day 3 – Doddabetta Peak + Tea Factory + Return Journey

 - a. Doddabetta Peak – Highest in Nilgiris (2,637 m); panoramic views (Entry ₹10).
 - b. Tea Factory & Museum – Learn tea processing, free tasting (Entry ₹20).

- Shop for Ooty homemade chocolates, eucalyptus oil, and Nilgiri tea.
